*EDITING:* Creating a full length cut of the project using both single and multicamera tracks. Condensing the initial cut into a standard movie duration while retaining all notable aspects of the event being documented. Constructing cinematic trailers, released online, for upcoming projects.

AUDIO MIXING / COLOR GRADING: Mixing levels and cleaning errors within multiple audio sources to create the final audio output. Using color correction to match multiple cameras into a more visually-uniform scene. Applying additional color correction techniques to adapt the final cut of the project to either a documentary or more cinematic feel, depending on the client's specification.

*CAMERA:* Unloading, carrying, and setting up all camera/lighting/audio equipment. Assisting the main camera operator with lens changes, battery charging, etc. Giving input on potential shots and operating the second camera as needed. *GRAPHIC DESIGN:* Designing DVD and Blu-ray covers, complete with stills from the finished film and title fonts based on the colors and styles implemented at the event itself. Additionally, a circular variation of the main design is created to be printed on the disc itself. Collaboration on the design of the 2012 company logo, as well as creative input into the August 2014 website redesign.

PRODUCTION: Building DVD and Blu-ray menus, including submenus for scene selection and special features. Testing finished discs for errors. Assembling DVD and Blu-ray cases for shipping.
